Eligibility:

Open to all PSNH members in the United States. Artists may enter up to 2 paintings. Work must be ORIGINAL SOFT pastels only (No less than 80%). No oil pastels. No classroom or workshop work allowed. If you are uncertain about your membership status, please contact our Membership Chair: mffsmith@gmail.com

Entry:

Fee for 1 painting: \$15, 2 paintings \$25. Paypal or check payable to PSNH.

Requirements:

Size Limit: Maximum 18" x 24" in any direction (not including frame.) All works must be securely framed and ready to hang (no sawtooth!). Please include label information for artwork submitted (available in the Entry Form).

Calendar:

- Monday 15 October: Application deadline
- Drop off date, Levenson room: Tuesday 10/30, 1-4:30PM. A list of participants will be provided to coordinate drop offs if necessary
- Hanging of artwork: November 1
- Reception date: Sunday 11/4, 2-4PM. Pastel instructional demo by Joelle Feldman
- Demos: Lisa Regopoulos, Sunday 11 November, 2-4PM. Tom Bradley, Saturday 17 November, 2-4PM
- Pick up dates, Levenson room: Friday 11/30, 1-5PM, Saturday 12/1, 1-4PM

No commission will be taken for art sold. Purchases will be made directly with the artist. A price list and artist information will be available for potential buyers.
